# NOTE D'INTENTION

MOTS DE L'ARTISTE

### 66

My artistic exploration looks at the many facets of nature's creativity, drawing on its mathematical, spiritual and visual dimensions. In particular, I explore fractals.

- Discovered by the mathematician Benoît Mandelbrot in 1980, fractals are geometric shapes that can be divided into parts, each part being a reduced version of the whole, rather like the structure of a broccoli plant, for example. They are now used to understand and describe nature in science.

This symbol, omnipresent in nature, is found in a variety of forms such as corals, mosses, roots and trees, embodying both complexity and simplicity, chaos and order, finitude and infinity. At the moment when ink meets water, I witness the immediate emergence of creativity, a fleeting moment when time dissolves and a portal to the infinite unfolds before me. Art has become my spiritual journey, a way of connecting with the profound beauty of nature and experiencing the power of the present moment.

#### SHAPE OF WATER

The "Shape of water" series questions the original form of water. An elusive entity to the human eye, water takes on the shape of its container, conforming to its receptacle. However, under any constraint, water always strives to regain its initial movement. Whether water is flowing in a river, flowing through pipes or pulsing inside our own bodies, it manifests its own movement. It is precisely this phenomenon that I highlight in my ceramic sculptures and paintings. These works represent paintings in quadratic shapes, similar to frames where water struggles to emerge and express itself freely.

My artistic work is based on the work of the mathematician Benoit Mandelbrot on fractals, the work of the scientist Theodor Schwenk on the shape of water and the poetic account of the journey of a drop of water by the writer Zulma Carraud.

Enjoy your journey through the movements of water,





















# MYRIEM HIMMICH GALLERY

Myriem Himmich Gallery, based in Casablanca, is a contemporary art gallery that opened on 11 February 2022.

The gallery is particularly interested in innovative, experimental and spiritual art. Its mission is to unveil and support artists who take a fresh, raw look at art.

The gallery presents a diversified annual calendar of exhibitions that can be presented in 5 sections: the major section corresponding to the visual arts, Design & Crafts, Art & Literature, Art & Music and finally a section dedicated to Artistic Humanitarian Missions.

The gallery offers multi-sensory solo and group exhibitions that capture the public's gaze and immerse them in an immersive experience. They engage our multiple senses beyond mere sight, creating a deeper connection with the artist and his or her world.

Myriem Himmich Gallery represents local and international artists. It has exhibited solo shows by the artists Zineb Mezzour, Valérie Ohana and Bouchra El Menjra, whom the gallery represents in Morocco and internationally. The gallery is also supporting 15 other artists in group shows. It offers them not only a platform for presenting their work, but also privileged access to its network.

The gallery took part in the 1-54 African contemporary art fair in Marrakech in February 2024 and presented the work of Zineb Mezzour, Valérie Ohana and Bouchra El Menjra.
